There are three (3) proposals from Minneapolis for a proposed Vikings Stadium. One is the Metrodome site, one is the Farmer's Market site, and the last is the Xcel Energy site.

We have asked Terri Ashmore, from the Basilica of St. Mary's, to come into our Community Forum and share with us their concerns regarding a Vikings Stadium at the Xcel Energy Site. The Basilica is a valued partner in the Loring Park Community and an active member of CLPC.

We will also be asking David Fields from Elliot Park to come in and share with us the Downtown Neighborhood's preference for the Metrodome site. Chuck Leer has confirmed his attendance and can speak on the proposed Farmers' Market Site. We are also working on getting a representative from the Xcel Site to attend. We have asked that all speak on the pros and cons for each site, and share their vision for each of the three proposed Minneapolis sites.
